A motion was made by Alderman Hoffman and seconded by Alderman Chernowsky to approve Ordinance #08-2024 – AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING A MUNICIPAL GROCERY RETAILERS' OCCUPATION TAX AND A MUNICIPAL GROCERY SERVICE OCCUPATION TAX FOR THE CITY OF ATHENS, ILLINOIS. Motion was roll called, Alderman Thompson and Lantz voted no, Alderman Chernowsky, Puma, Leinberger, and Hoffman voted aye. Motion passed 4-2.

A motion was made by Alderman Lantz and seconded by Alderman Puma to accept the bid from Central Illinois Tree Service for a 3-year contract for city wide tree trimming. Motion was roll called, Alderman Thompson and Hoffman voted no. Alderman Chernowsky, Puma, Lantz, Leinberger voted aye. Motion passed 4-2.

A motion was made by Alderman Hoffman and seconded by Alderman Leinberger to accept the bid from A-Team Disposal for a 3-year contract for city wide garbage service. Motion was roll called, all present voted aye. Motion passed.
