The City of Athens Council met for a regularly scheduled council meeting on Monday, March 17, 2025. Mayor Chris Reichert called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. The roll call indicated that Alderman Amy Chernowsky, Alderman Kevin Puma, Alderman Rachel Lantz, Alderman Kyra Leinberger, and Alderman Angella Thompson were present. Alderman Hoffman was absent.

A motion was made by Alderman Lantz and seconded by Alderman Puma to approve the purchase of 6 new office phones for a total of \$1,050.00. Motion was roll called, all present in favor voted aye. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Alderman Chernowsky and seconded by Alderman puma to approve Resolution #2025-02R – Resolution Authorizing Execution of a Service Agreement with the Lowest Responsible Bidder for the Supply of Electricity for Residential and Small Commercial Retail Customers who do not opt-out of such a program.
